Mass cards for both living and deceased relatives / friends are available by the door and in the Parish Office. The suggested donation is \$10.

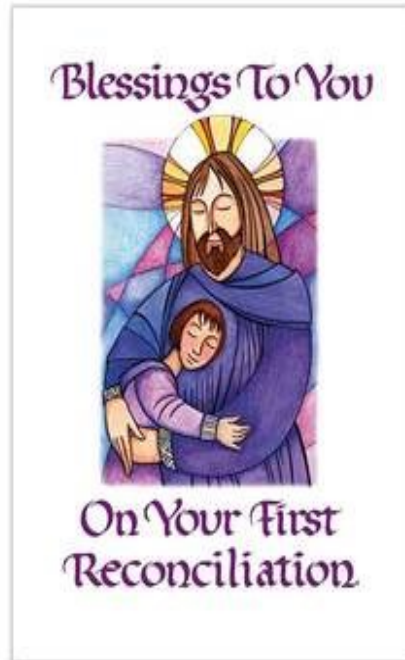
